WELCOME

As Christians, we praise our Lord Jesus when we come to receive His grace that He so freely bestows upon us. We are delighted, therefore, that you have come to join us today to worship God's Son, Jesus who shed His blood on the Cross to deliver us from our sins.

THE LORD'S SUPPER AT TRINITY

Our congregation celebrates the Lord's Supper as Scripture teaches that it is the central unifying expression of the body of Christ with Her Lord, and with one another in doctrine and faith. In this regard, as a member of the LC-MS, we therefore have promised to observe the practice of "Closed Communion" in love and support of our doctrinal unity. Because of this, we respectfully ask those from other fellowships to refrain from coming to our communion rail as we believe those who receive The Lord's Supper are called to confess the same holy faith in unity as Scripture teaches. **If you should have any questions about this, please speak with Pastor before the service. (See also the brochure in the pew rack.) If you are physically unable to come forward to receive The Lord's Supper, please let Pastor or an Elder know before the service.**

Non-alcoholic wine is available in the center cups on the trays and is a lighter color. The Non-alcoholic wine is NOT available from the chalice. Gluten free wafers are available for those with sensitivity. Please let the Pastor or Elder know if you would prefer this option.

EXHORTATION AND CONFESSION OF SINS

Psalm 124:8; Psalm 130:3–4; Luke 18:13

P Our help is in the name of the Lord,

C **who made heaven and earth.**

P If You, O Lord, kept a record of sins, O Lord, who could stand?

C **But with You there is forgiveness; therefore You are feared.**

P Since we are gathered to hear God’s Word, call upon Him in prayer and praise, and receive the body and blood of our Lord Jesus Christ in the fellowship of this altar, let us first consider our unworthiness and confess before God and one another that we have sinned in thought, word, and deed, and that we cannot free ourselves from our sinful condition. Together as His people let us take refuge in the infinite mercy of God, our heavenly Father, seeking His grace for the sake of Christ, and saying: God, be merciful to me, a sinner.

Be Seated or Kneel as you are able—Silence for reflection on God’s Word and for self-examination.

EPISTLE: PHILIPPIANS 3:8-14, 20-21

Indeed, I count everything as loss because of the surpassing worth of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord. For his sake I have suffered the loss of all things and count them as rubbish, in order that I may gain Christ and be found in him, not having a righteousness of my own that comes from the law, but that which comes through faith in Christ, the righteousness from God that depends on faith— that I may know him and the power of his resurrection, and may share his sufferings, becoming like him in his death, that by any means possible I may attain the resurrection from the dead.

Not that I have already obtained this or am already perfect, but I press on to make it my own, because Christ Jesus has made me his own. Brothers, I do not consider that I have made it my own. But one thing I do: forgetting what lies behind and straining forward to what lies ahead, I press on toward the goal for the prize of the upward call of God in Christ Jesus.

But our citizenship is in heaven, and from it we await a Savior, the Lord Jesus Christ, who will transform our lowly body to be like his glorious body, by the power that enables him even to subject all things to himself.

HOLY GOSPEL: LUKE 20:9-20

P The Holy Gospel according to St. Luke, the twentieth chapter.

C **Glory to You, O Lord.**

[Jesus] began to tell the people this parable: "A man planted a vineyard and let it out to tenants and went into another country for a long while. When the time came, he sent a servant to the tenants, so that they would give him some of the fruit of the vineyard. But the tenants beat him and sent him away empty-handed. And he sent another servant. But they also beat and treated him shamefully, and sent him away empty-handed. And he sent yet a third. This one also they wounded and cast out. Then the owner of the vineyard said, 'What shall I do? I will send my beloved son; perhaps they will respect him.' But when the tenants saw him, they said to themselves, 'This is the heir. Let us kill him, so that the inheritance may be ours.' And they threw him out of the vineyard and killed him. What then will the owner of the vineyard do to them? He will come and destroy those tenants and give the vineyard to others." When they heard this, they said, "Surely not!" But he looked directly at them and said, "What then is this that is written:

'The stone that the builders rejected
has become the cornerstone'?

Everyone who falls on that stone will be broken to pieces, and when it falls on anyone, it will crush him."

The scribes and the chief priests sought to lay hands on him at that very hour, for they perceived that he had told this parable against them, but they feared the people. So they watched him and sent spies, who pretended to be sincere, that they might catch him in something he said, so as to deliver him up to the authority and jurisdiction of the governor.


PREFACE

THE WORDS OF OUR LORD


